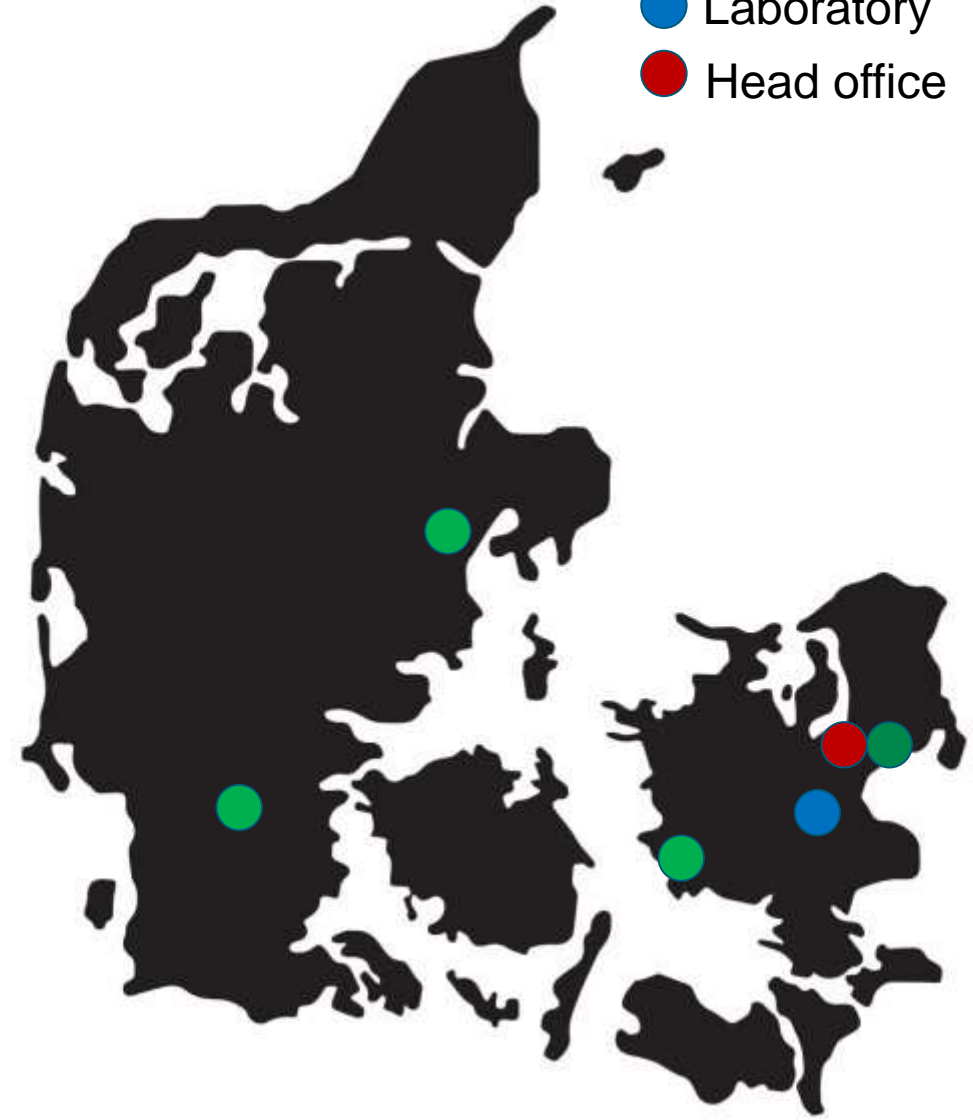

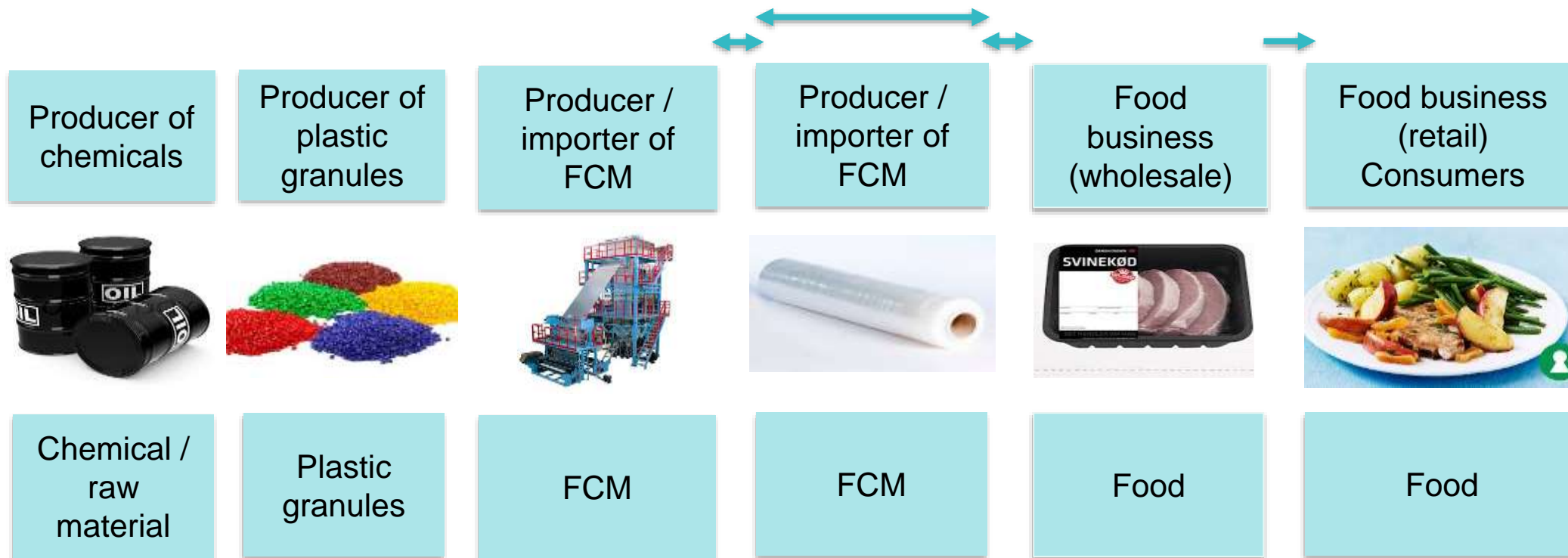

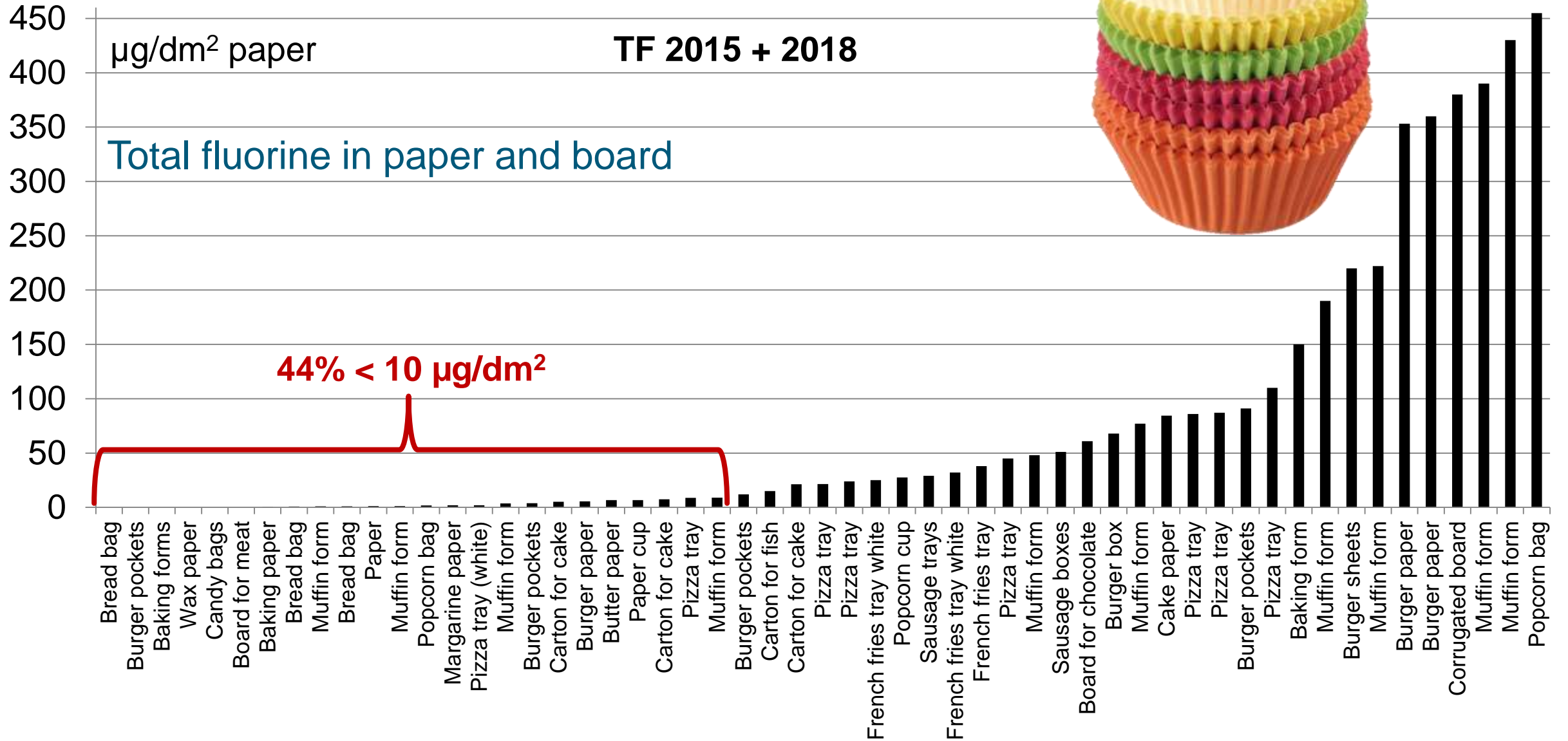

Notification of the Danish ban on PFAS in paper and board FCM

§ 7. Food contact materials made of board and paper in which per- and polyfluorinated alkylated substances (PFAS) have been used may not be placed on the market.

Paragraph 2 Notwithstanding paragraph 1, food contact materials made of board and paper in which per- and polyfluorinated substances (PFAS) have been used may be placed on the market if a **functional barrier** is used in the product to prevent the substances from migrating into the food.
